


# Dizzy Diamonds Quilt


Finished Measurement 65" by 85" - Suitable for a Queen-Size Mattress


# Fabric Requirements

- A  Pink - 1-1/2 yd  
Cut 4- 6" WOF strips; 1- 24" WOF strip  
Subcut 24- 6" squares; 6- 6" x 24" rectangles
- B  Yellow - 1-1/2 yd  
Cut 4- 6" WOF strips; 1- 29.5" WOF strip  
Subcut 24- 6" squares; 6- 6" x 29.5" rectangles
- C  Pine Green - 1 yd  
Cut 5- 6" WOF strips  
Subcut 24- 6" squares, cut 2- 10"x5" rectangles
- D  Brick Red - 3/4 yd  
Cut 4- 6" WOF strips  
Subcut 24- 6" squares
- E  Cornflower Blue - 3/4 yd  
Cut 4- 6" WOF strips  
Subcut 24- 6" squares
- F  Red(s) - 3/4 yd  
Cut 4- 6" WOF strips  
Subcut 24- 6" squares,  
Or collect 6" squares of scrap fabrics in red hues


**Binding:** 1/2 Yard of Fabric  
Cut 8- 2-1/4" WOF strips  
Sew together on a 45° angle at ends to make 310" of Single-fold binding.

**Backing:** 4-1/2 yards

An alternative way to finish the quilt could be to sew the 3 main blocks into two strips, and place the side strips in the middle, facing outward. I encourage you to use this free pattern in any way you see fit within the bounds of your non-commercial quilting <3





# Instructions - Center Block (Make 6)


For each block, lay out the 6" squares in the pattern on the right.  
 If you want to make all 6 blocks at the same time, sew together 6 strips each in the following order:

- B>C
- A>C>B>D
- E>C>A>D>B>F
- C>E>D>A>F>B
- D>E>F>A
- F>E
- Press Seams Open.





Arrange strips in the order on the right  
 Attach in, order matching seams  
 to ensure correct positioning,  
 especially when lengths of strips  
 being joined are different.

Press all Seams Open.




Make 6 Blocks in this manner  
 (cont. on next page)





Turn the block 90° and trim to a 23-3/8" square, lining up 1/4" edge of a ruler with the intersections of the squares. Leave 1/4" of the block from those intersections for your seam allowance.

Be sure to leave the trimmed off triangles intact as you will use them in the final step.





Reserve trimmed off triangles


## Make the Quilt Tilt!

Cut all 6 of each, 24" color A and 29.5" color B Strips diagonally, from top left to bottom right, 1" from each edge. The edges you made while cutting are what you will sew to the main blocks.




Sew color A strips to opposite sides of each pieced square. Align the 90° corner of the strip with the right edge of the block when pinning. There will be overhang on either side, but it should be about equal. The side you choose to start with here determines the orientation of the main block, so let your creativity blossom and mix it up like in the sample quilt.

Press Seams Open. Trim the excess, flush with the raw edges of the main block.



Sew color B strips to remaining sides of each pieced square orienting the thick part of the triangle to the Right.  
 Align the 90° corner of the strip with the top right edge of the Color A Strips when pinning.  
 There will be overhang on both sides, but it should be about equal.

Press Seams Open. Trim the block to 28" Square.




To construct the side strips you will first sew together triangles from your block trimmings, along their hypotenuse into Half-Square Triangles (HSTs).




You should have 6x this pile of triangles from trimming the main block for this step

Make HSTs in the following combinations:


- 6 - Color A/D
- 6 - Colors D/F
- 6 - Colors F/E
- 6 - Colors C/A
- 4 - Colors E/B
- 4 - Colors B/C
- 2 - Colors C/E




Sew together. Press Open.  
 Trim to 4.5" Square



Arrange the Trimmed HSTs as well as the two Color E 10"x5" rectangles into the strip shown below.  
 Sew together and press all seams open.



Make 2



Assemble the tilted blocks as shown into a 2 x 3 grid. Line up the C/E HST Side of each strip with the main grid. Sew the side strips to the grid on either long side, making sure that the centered triangle points inward and that the Color C Rectangles are on opposite sides of each other. The Color C rectangles will be longer than the main center and will need trimmed after assembly. For other assembly options see Page 2's alternative finish.

Sandwich the finished quilt top with batting and a backing. Quilt and Bind to your liking :)
